Task Force:	Details:
Entertainment	Recruit performers: singers, musicians, dancers, and story tellers.
Food	Organize food vendors: cultural cuisine and beverages.
Green	Arrange for zero waste stations, clean up.
Fun for kids	Brainstorm activities to keep the “little ones” entertained.
Fashion	Organize a cultural fashion show.
Cultural Exhibitions	Find cultural crafts, art, and clothes to display at festival.
Promotion	Create a promotional plan: fliers, posters, social media, radio, & TV.
Volunteers	Support each task force team by recruiting festival volunteers.
Info Booths and Wellness Services	Liaise with service providers to create an engaging health and wellness fair.
Decoration	Help make the festival look beautiful! Includes creating a plan for set up, take down, and cleaning of decor.
Survey	Create a system for recording festival feedback: verbal, visual, guest book, canvas signage, & survey forms
Fundraising	Help us fund the festival! Seek out sponsors, donors, grants, and sell raffle and event tickets in new and innovative ways.
Fun Activities	This is a fun one! Organize a few festival activities, such as an “Amazing Race”, Geocaching contest, Facebook contest, radio contest, door-prizes & more
Logistics	Create a festival program, follow-up with team members and community requests, find equipment, supplies, and guest speakers
Communications	Let’s get as many people to this event as possible! Help “spread the word” by giving presentations to schools, organizations, sub-communities, business, and media groups

Volunteer Assistance	Create a station for event volunteers (including food and refreshments)
Set Up & Clean Up	Be part of the set up and clean-up crew. We are going to need “all hands on deck”!
Elder Care	Help create a welcoming and comfortable atmosphere for our community’s Elders.
